

# Hemming Park Itinerary



Address: 135 W Monroe St, Jacksonville, FL 32202

- Park your car at the Kings Avenue Station and enjoy the free ride over to Downtown. Take the Skyway (Mary St, Jacksonville, FL 32207) over to Hemming Park. The Skyway runs from 6 a.m.- 9 p.m. Bring your camera along to snap photos of Jacksonville's skyline when riding over the Acosta bridge.
- Hemming Park, is a 1.5-acre public square in the center of the city, it is Jacksonville's first and oldest park and the site of many significant historic events. Hemming is a kid friendly park with a dedicated Kids Zone for children to enjoy, there are also benches to sit and relax on.
- When you are ready for lunch, try one of the food trucks at Hemming Park where they have different trucks Monday - Friday. After grabbing a bite to eat, head right across Laura street to the Jacksonville Main Library. The little ones can have fun in the interactive Children's section.
- Next door to the Main Library is Museum Of Contemporary Art, be sure to spend some time in this museum and gift shop.
- End the day with grabbing a sweet treat at Sweet Pete's (400 N Hogan St, Jacksonville, FL 32202). When you are ready to head home, head back up the escalator at Hemming Park Station and ride the Skyway back to your car.
