
## Tillie K. Fowler Park Itinerary



• Start the day off by exploring the off-road bike trails near the front of the park. Tillie Fowler is a dog friendly park with plenty of activities you can enjoy with your furry friend. If you brought your dog along for the park adventure, start your day by parking at the playground and walking over to the dog park

area. Tillie Fowler has two dog parks.

 Time to hike! Start the day by exploring one of the trails. Tower Trails is the shorter of the two trails. Tower Trail is 1.2 miles round trip and leads to an observation tower that overlooks the Ortega river. The second trail is the Island Trail which is 2.25 miles round trip with a bridge to cross over some wetlands. Both trail heads can be accessed near the back of the park. Both trails allow for dogs and bikes.

 Near the dog park, you'll notice a historic sign. On the left is an old brick road. This brick road is 16 ft wide and runs through Jacksonville. The road was used during World War 1 for the workers from Jacksonville going to Camp Joseph Johnston.
